

Is social media an effective tool for young adults to expose their authentic self to present themselves?

Abstract

This paper will argue on whether a person can be authentic and anonymous at the same time. Social media is a platform where each individual connected needs to provide all their ethnic self on their profile. Those younger adults have better prestige as they have good communication skills when it is clearly seen on their social media platforms where they interact with their friends on pictures they post. Concurrently, in the web 2.0, social media has become a modern tool which is used by all young adults to have the knowledge of participating and understanding the concepts related to their world.

According to Lee (2004), the site True.com have indeed conducted background checks on online dating users and has introduced legislation which is necessary to verify whether the information added on the account is authentic or not. It is important to do all these background checks so as not to hurt anyone's feelings (Ellison et al., 2017). In 2003, 29 millions of Americans were using online dating application (Gershberg, 2004). In addition, there were uniquely 40 millions of visitors to the online dating sites each month in U.S (CBC News, 2004) whereby they were making new friends online. Thus, it is the liberal mode of identity that younger adults decide where they shall connect themselves vividly to provide all their personal information to find another individual of their choice and live in a long term relationship (St. John, 2002). It focuses mainly on the content on managing their online self. This is so because of the Post Marxist perspective, which is a philosophy of how people's identity have been formed only through interactions that have reformed their identity more specifically. Social media can really create a bond between two people to perform themselves in terms of how to present, create and maintain a favorable image projected to other people. It creates a very important aspect in every individual's life who are connected to online dating platform because it renews to the focus of authenticity which is always viewed online by providing details such that location and contact details or whether they have mutual friends in common or not. At last, they finally meet offline too to know their dating partner who they are currently talking to online to, to see if they are online authenticity reflects on their real life also.

By the same token, on Facebook, true self and real personality is the most important to them. On the flipside of the coin, young adults have the right to keep their private information anonymous where the online privacy protection is paramount for each individual who have access to Facebook particularly because of how people interact with the internet. Nowadays, even on the internet, it has become a crucial fact for people to protect their identity so that they do not face dangerous issues in the future (Liljander, Gummerus, & Söderlund, 2015). Information of the owner should not be shared without permission. According to researchers, this can therefore lead to an identity fraud where all the personal details of the owner has been stolen. Young adults eschew the willingness to share their information, for instance, their name, age and image so that they could avoid dangers for themselves because of strangers. According to Christofides (2009), young adults have the option to control who have the authority to view their shared information as vivid as all the post that is on their timeline which is a reflecting of no violation of privacy because their identity remains anonymous. While being anonymous, people are having fun when posting online and they are exploring aspects which are not exposing themselves. In the same vein, tensions have been raised for those younger adults because they think that with the privacy that Facebook has offered, they have the benefit to self-disclose themselves to strangers which is not at all obligatory. Young adults have the right to decide whether they will put their true self on privacy or not. Walther (2011) states that, “The behavior of teenagers have changed because there are teenagers who make illegal statement, insulting and make foolish act in their profiles” (para. 3) where they act without consequence because their self is hidden.

In a nutshell, this paper has mainly discussed the three main points of authentic self and has argued that it is crucial to provide details of one’s identity to the social media platforms for specific reasons. Much more, in creating a good reputation in the world of working places, where the evidence is mainly in the profile of the employees who are looking for the job. It is also an advantage to the online dating app because people consider all the details authentic on the platform and even on Facebook young adults are at ease with the information section that is provided online. One future prediction is that it is better to provide all the ethnic details on platforms and have privacy at the same time on the profiles of those individuals.

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
